Green fingers



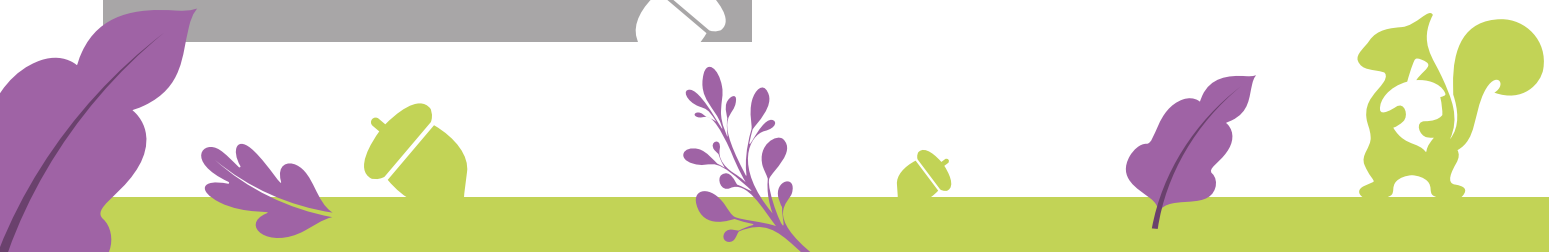
